The Ringwood Manor Association of the Arts is offering our members the opportunity to sketch and photograph the interior of the historic Manor House on the grounds of Ringwood Manor State Park. Access to the manor rooms will be the same as during house tours – some areas will be stanchioned-off to protect historic items.

There will be two separate session days, one for sketching/drawing and one for photography – please see the dates & times at the top of this form.

Note: Space is limited, so, you must pre-register and bring a signed copy of this form with you to your session. If you forget your form, some copies will be on-hand for signature

Eligibility and Fee: This is open exclusively to members of the RMAA. The fee for a spot is \$10. You can register on the RMAA's website or send \$10 via PayPal to rmaa2008@aol.com and let us know in the PayPal notes which session you are registering for.

As preservation of this historic site and prevention of accidental damage is of the utmost importance, please review and agree to the below:

Sketching & Drawing

- Pencils, pens, and markers are allowed. Paints, charcoal, and pastels are not allowed to be used inside of the Manor House. Feel free to take sketches or reference photos and use 'messier' materials outside.
- There will be chairs available. You may want to bring a lap-desk or other support surface for working.
- Easels are allowed, provided that the legs are deemed to not be hazardous to the floor and that the utmost care is used when moving it to avoid hitting doorways, historic objects, etc. As always, respect the requests of RMAA volunteers and park staff.

Photography

- Expect the usual challenges of photographing indoors.
- On camera flash use is allowed. Off-camera flash and lighting and/or light stands is not allowed.
- Monopod/Tripod use is allowed, provided that the legs are deemed to not be hazardous to the floor and that the utmost care is used when moving it to avoid hitting doorways, historic objects, etc. As always, respect the requests of RMAA volunteers and park staff.

General

- Please respect the requests of RMAA volunteers and park staff. This is a historic site and its preservation is the priority.
- At present mask use inside of the building is optional. As the COVID-19 situation is fluid, this could change by the time of the events, so please come prepared. If you feel ill, please stay home.
- All use of drawings, sketches, paintings, photographs, or any other images derived from these sessions is to be non-commercial. Use of these images in art shows, exhibitions, and sales are allowed. Use in magazines, advertising of any sort, or in any other commercial manner is prohibited. If there is a question on a given use, please ask!
